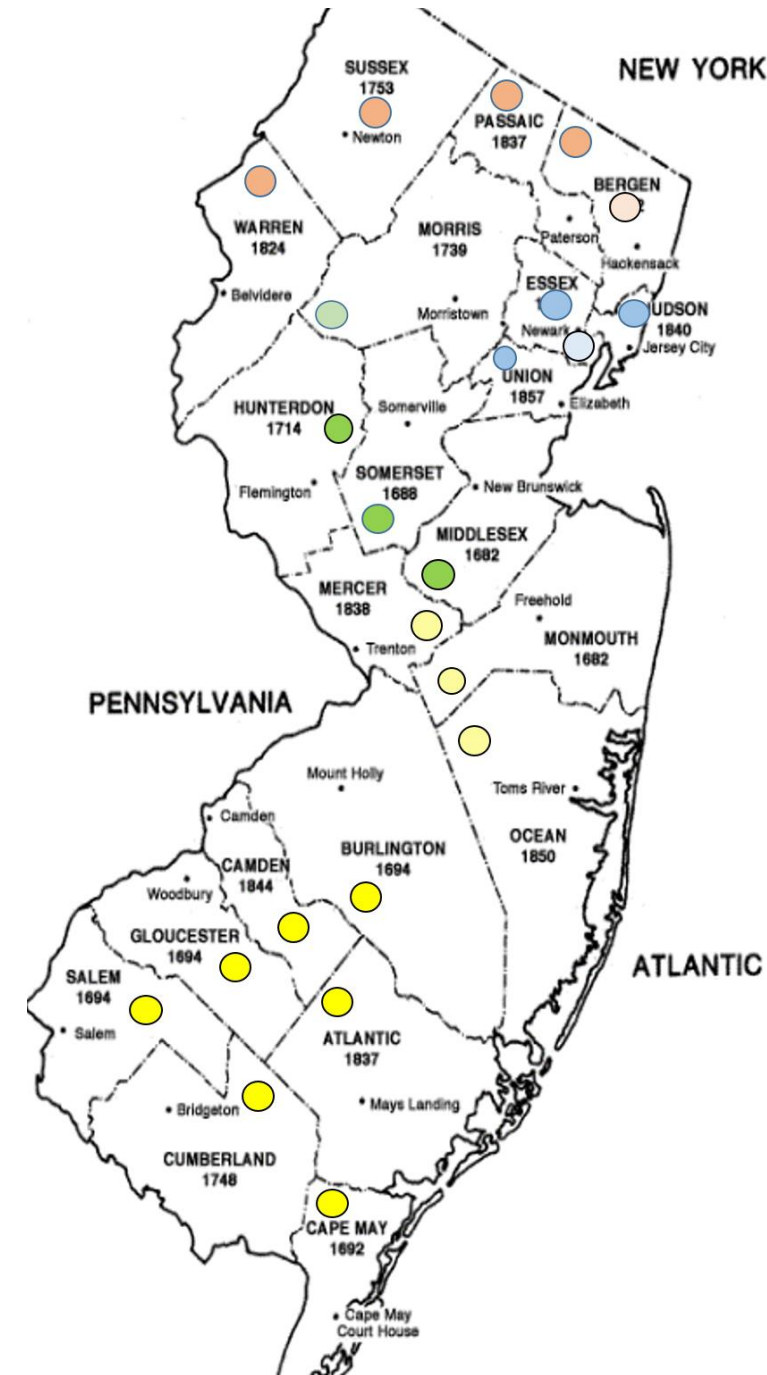
### **UPPER CENTRAL LEAGUE**

# Concept Plan : Raritan Valley Science & Technology Showcase (FTC Area)



## Notes:

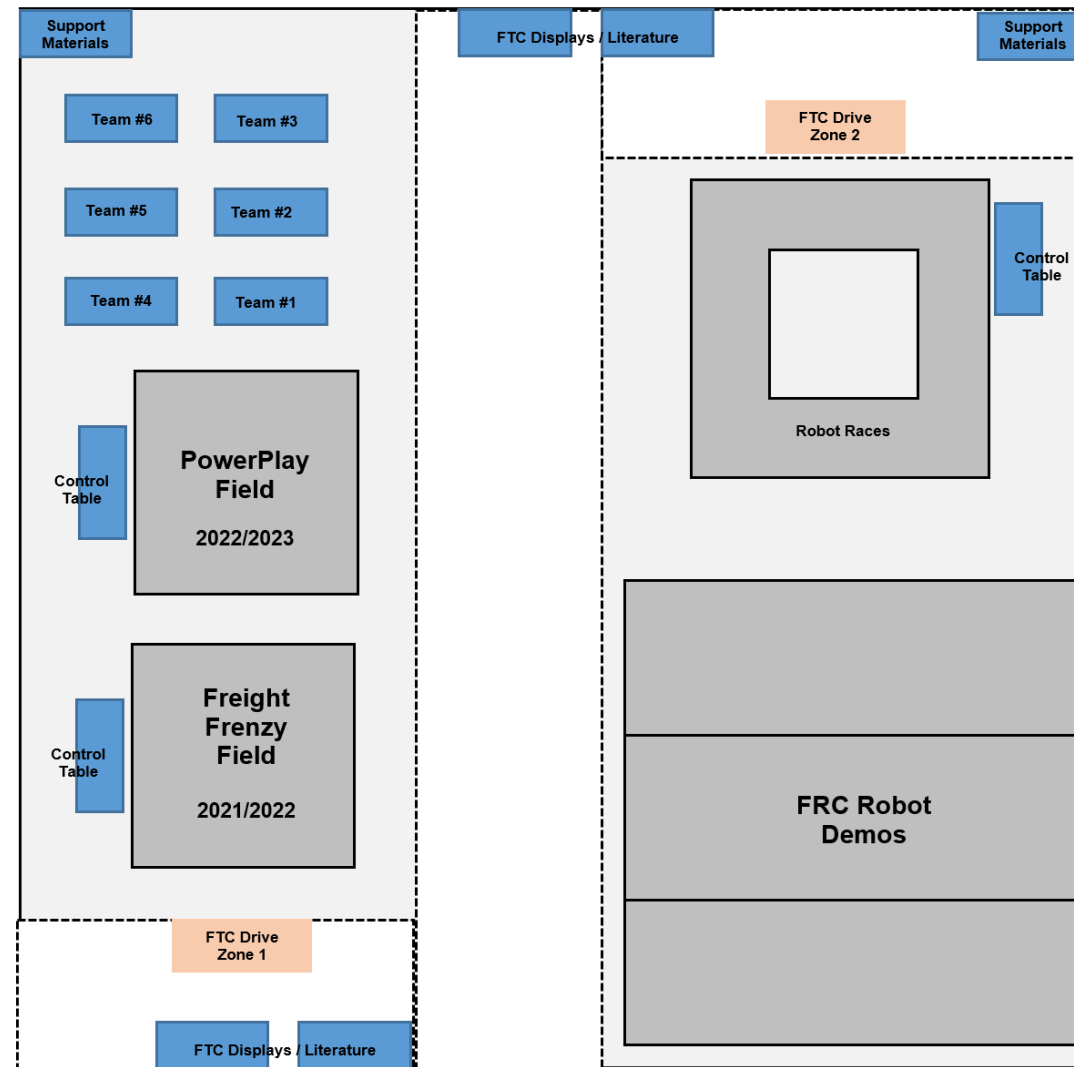
- 10' wide Aisle down center of area for spectators (in safe white zones only)

## Left Side

- FIRST / FTC Info immediately inside door
- Spectators can watch Freight Frenzy robots, assuming teams with last year's robots...
  - ...otherwise Mall Youth can drive a "jersey-bot" on the Freight Frenzy Field while standing in the safe "Drive Zone 1" area.
- Current FTC teams will be debugging their new robots on the official PowerPlay field. First time for many.
- Six tables for teams to tinker on this year's bots. Senior teams are on Tables #1, #2, #3 to answer spectator questions
- Extra table for Support Materials.

## Right Side

- FRC Area is 25' x 25'
- Expanded FTC Field is 16' x 16' with walled empty space in the center to simulate a racetrack.
- Spectators find FTC literature at the entrance to the Drive Zone 2 area.
  - Mall Youth face the field and drive their robots around the track.

## Second Floor Showcase Tables

- In addition to all that is shown to the left, there will be 2-3 FTC teams located with other FIRST Programs in a common area on the second floor.
- Those teams will talk about FIRST, and FTC to raise interest and direct people to visit the FTC area (at left) located on the first floor of the mall.
  - A team that volunteers to help out may likely spend time in multiple areas of the FTCNJ exhibition.
